(Apologies for only just looping you in,

After reviewing your revision, we determined only minor edits were needed to bring your manuscript to the finish line. Great work!

In the attached PDF, you'll see copy edits and notes. Let me know if you have any questions about them.

Two specific notes:

- Make sure you put the thesis (the answer to your RQs) in the introduction. You can consider distilling the conclusion (especially the last paragraph) into 1-2 sentences. I know you have a thesis, I see it in the manuscript! There's a clear analytical culmination to all the literature review-ing you did you just need to make sure you put an explicit "whiff" of it in the introduction.
- Also, the explanation about using the terms "economically developing and developed" countries was clear and helpful.

Once you implement these changes, it will be on track to be in the May issue. We typically give 2 weeks for minor edits—so **Saturday, March 1**—but let me know if you need more time. You can use the same link above to resubmit.

Again, wonderful work—this was a rich manuscript with great scholarly value.
