### About the Meeting

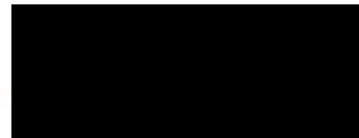
Information research and practice are embedded in diverse settings, from physical library, everyday life, and community spaces to digital entertainment and social media, to online search systems. These real-world and virtual spaces consist of complex, interdependent relationships between **people, information objects, and technologies** that are mediated by local norms and practices and broader economic and political systems.

As information scientists and practitioners, we are perpetually mindful of the *people* in the information-technology-people triad, even in the face of the dramatic rise of AI systems.

- We consider the ways in which human-designed and algorithmic systems represent individuals and communities, sometimes reinforcing and perpetuating stigma and discrimination.
- We see how biases embedded in social media, information retrieval, classification, and decision-making systems influence the flow of information in society.
- We understand that complex societal challenges (e.g., mis/disinformation, access to information, technological sustainability) involve but also transcend individual actions and dispositions.

At the same time, empowering people with information, metaliteracy, and tools is vital for engendering systemic change, fostering creativity and innovation, and improving the quality of interactions with information systems.

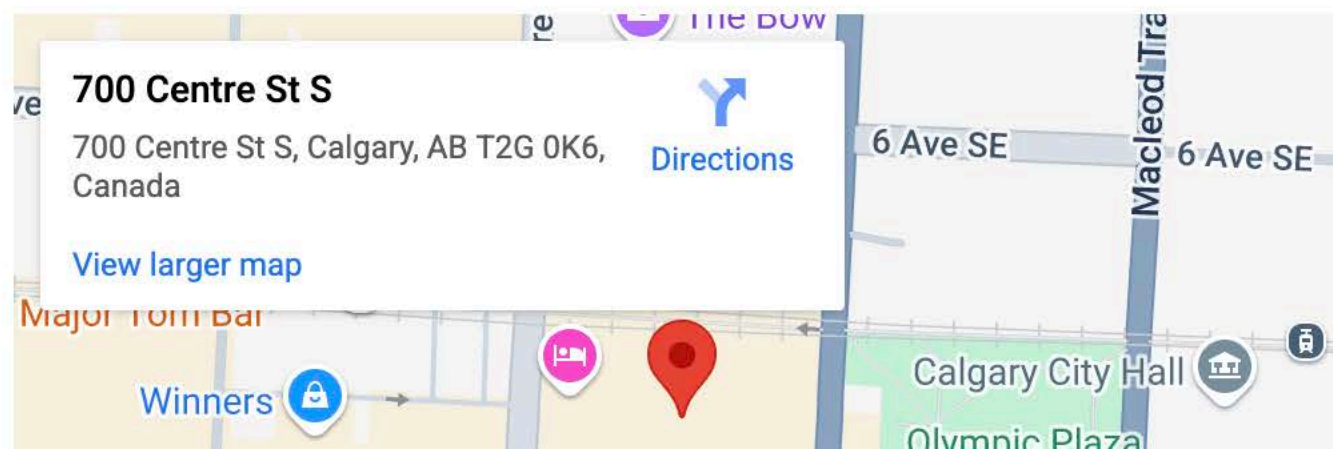
